

Code of Conduct



- Win with humility play for enjoyment, not just to please your parents/coaches.
- Play by the laws of the game.
- Never argue with the referee's decision.
- Play with control. Do not lose your temper.
- Play for yourself and your team.
- Respect your opponent. Treat all players as you would like to be treated yourself.
- Do not 'bully' or take advantage of any player.
- Co-operate with referees, coaches, team mates and opponents.
- Players will respect their coaches and take their instruction.
- Any disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated by the club and may lead to suspension from club activities.
- Remember that the goals of the game are to have fun, improve your skills, and feel good.
- At the final whistle applaud and thank your opponents and the referee for the match.
- Always remember that you owe a duty of care to your opponents.
- Lose with dignity. Nobody likes a sore loser.
- Do not attempt to cheat by diving or feigning injury in an attempt to con the referee.
- Your own age group is your first priority.
- It is most important that you don't keep secrets. Tell your clubs Child Welfare Officer, your parents or anyone you trust if someone is causing you harm or distress.
- You have a right to be safe.
