- 1. I may be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager.
- 2. I may receive a formal warning from the Coach/Manager or the Kildrum Tigers Football Club Management Committee.
- 3. I may be dropped or substituted.
- 4. I may be suspended from training.
- 5. I may be required to leave Kildrum Tigers Football Club (Youths).

In addition Kildrum Tigers Management Committee will make my parent/carer aware of any infringements of this Code of Conduct.

A fine and or suspension could be imposed against Kildrum Tigers Football Club (Youths) in serious matters.
