



A Portal Frame Unit 14.4m long in 3 no. 4.8m bays by 7.6m wide by 3.8m clear under rafter at eaves over top of finished floor. Roof sheeted in non-drip box profile Euronit (formally Tegral) ColorGalv, grey in colour including 2 No. rooflights per bay. One side and both gables sheeted in box profile ColorGalv, down to wall 6ft high over foundation level. Barges & flashings supplied and fitted to match the cladding plus 2 No. run of 100mm bevel gutters with 2 No. stacks of 100mm wavin downpipes. 150mm x 75mm imported and treated timber purlins.

 delivery by artic truck.
