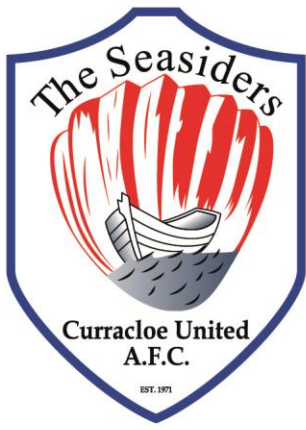

Curracloue United AFC - Club Guidelines for Players – Season 2022/2023

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. Play your part and observe The FAI's Code of Conduct and Good Practice for Players. Respect Code of Always conduct for players. Curracloue United AFC is asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

On and off the field, I will:

- ✓ Adhere to the Laws of The Game
- ✓ Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- ✓ Promote Fair Play
- ✓ Always respect the match officials' decisions
- ✓ Never engage in public criticism of the match officials, including social media.
- ✓ Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- ✓ Never engage in bullying, intimidation or harassment
- ✓ Speak to my team-mates, the opposition and my coach/manager with respect
- ✓ Remember we all make mistakes.
- ✓ Win or lose with dignity. Shake hands with the opposing team and the referee at the end of every game.
- ✓ Resolve disputes according to club guidelines and policy.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any / all of the following actions may be taken by my club, League or The FAI:

I may:

- ✓ Be required to apologise to team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- ✓ Receive a warning from the coach
- ✓ Receive a written warning from the club committee
- ✓ Be required to attend an FAI education course
- ✓ Be dropped or substituted
- ✓ Be suspended from training
- ✓ Not be selected for the team /squad
- ✓ Be required to serve a suspension
- ✓ Be fined
- ✓ Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- ✓ The League / The FAI could impose a fine and suspension against my club. I am liable to pay the full amount of the fine as per club rule.
- ✓ I understand that the club committee reserves the right to revoke my membership should it consider that my conduct brings the club into disrepute.
