- 4) Let the coaches do their job and not confuse the children by giving instructions.

- 6) Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake mistakes are an important part of learning.
- 7) Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.

Failure to follow the code will result in the following. I may:

- 1) Issued with a verbal warning from the team coach or match official.
- 2) Obliged by the coach or match official to leave the match venue for the remainder of the game.
- 3) Requested to meet the club's committee to discuss the above.
- 4) Requested by the club not to attend future games.
- 5) Required to leave the club along with any dependants.
