

Code of Conduct - Parents

- **1.** Remember your child's coaches are volunteers who give up their time; show them respect and courtesy.
- 2. Remember that young people are involved in the sport for their enjoyment, not yours!
- **3.** Encourage your child to play within the rules of the game; remember it's not about winning at all costs.
- **4.** Actively help your child to improve their skills.
- **5.** Set a good example with your own conduct at games and training; show positive and constructive behaviour.
- 6. Never ridicule, humiliate or shout at young players for making a mistake. Encourage them through recognising the positive aspects of their play.
- **7.** Support our Club's efforts to provide and promote underage football in the area.
- **8.** Make the effort to watch your child playing football; they'll appreciate it.
- 9. Please respond to coaches' communications enquiring about your child's attendance at training or games. Arrangements depend on the replies.
- **10.**Be punctual; our Club is not a child minding service.
- **11.**Should any issues arise please feel free to speak to the coaches at the earliest opportunity
- **12.**Ensure that all contributions are paid as they are for the benefit of your child; this money buys the training equipment he will use.
