



Parents code of conduct

Parent/ Guardian Information:

In the event of illness/ health concerns or accidental injury, having parental responsibility, I give permission for medical treatment to be administered where considered necessary by a nominated first aider, or by suitably qualified medical practitioners. I give permission for a Mentor to contact my daughter's GP if required. If I cannot be contacted and my child needs emergency hospital treatment, I authorise a qualified medical practitioner to provide emergency treatment or medication.

I will respect the rules and procedures set down in the Ladies Gaelic Football Association's Code of

Ethics and Good Practice for Children in Sport.

- I will respect my child's team-mates and mentors (e.g. managers, coaches, selectors) and parents, as well as players, parents and coaches from opposing teams. I will encourage my child to treat other Players, Coaches, Selectors, and Managers with respect.
- I will respond to all texts from Team Managers and make my daughter available for Matches
- I will give encouragement and applaud positive accomplishments whether from my child, his/her teammates, their opponents or the officials.
- I will respect all Officials and their authority during matches.
- I will never demonstrate threatening or abusive behaviour or use foul language.
