- General behaviour:** Parents/Guardians and players are asked to show respect at all times to: Fellow players, Opponents, Referees, Coaches, Mentors, Officials, Club Property. Abuse, foul language and disrespect for any of the above by either a player or parent/guardian will not be tolerated by the club.
- Training** Regular attendance at training is essential to a player's development. However, if you are unable to attend a training session, please notify the trainer.
- Attire** Players must be punctual and suitably attired for both training and games. Club shorts and singlet are required for matches. Fines can be imposed on the club if players are not in full gear or if they turn up late for a game.
- Affiliation** **Only fully paid-up registered members are permitted to train & play with the club.** You are not covered by insurance if you have not registered fully and you are not eligible to play in games.
