Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians of Glanmire Ladies Basketball Club

PARENTS / GUARDIANS should encourage their child to:

- Play by the rules.
- Improve their skills levels.
- Appreciate everybody on their team, regardless of ability.

PARENTS / GUARDIANS should:

- Respect officials, coaches and mentors decisions and encourage children to do likewise.
- Not exert undue pressure on your child.
- Never admonish your own child or any other child for their standard of play.
- Be realistic in their expectations based on the child's/ children's ability.
- Show approval for effort, not just results.
- Never embarrass a child or use inappropriate remarks towards a player.
- Applaud good play from all teams.
- Not seek to unfairly affect a game or player.
- Follow the club rules and procedures.
- Support the club in fundraising events.
- Respect that all coaches, managers and club officials are giving voluntarily of their time and efforts and at all times have the best interests of the children and the club in mind.
- Not approach a coach directly after a game; this not permitted in the interest of all parties involved.
- Not seek to influence, pressurise, or in any way interfere with the selection process or technical aspects of the Squad/Team.
- Not utilise personal phone numbers of coaches and managers except to arrange a meeting to discuss participation or performance of child or confirm attendance or non-attendance at training/matches.
- Talk to the Club Children's Officer with any concerns or questions they may have.
