

GDPR Consent Policy

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force on 25 May 2018. In order for to be compliant the club needs to make you aware of certain data protection information relating to your (including players) personal data held by the club. The club also request that you opt-in to receiving communications from the club on club matters. You have the option to amend your options at anytime via the Online registration portal

The Club ('Granada FC') are Data Controllers of the personal data collected during your club player registration process ("Personal Data"). The legal basis for processing your Personal Data is that it is necessary for the performance of a contract and the purposes are; in order to register and maintain your membership with the Club.

Your Personal Data can be accessed by Club Committee Members, Managers, Coaches and by certain members of the associated leagues (E.g. SDFL, DDSL,FAI),. In the event of an injury or insurance claim, details of your claim which will include your Personal Data will be passed to the club insurance underwriters.

Personal Data will be used by the Club for the contractual purpose of registering (or re-registering) and maintaining Membership; the Personal Data will also be used for administrative purposes to maintain Membership including registrations, team-sheets, referee reports, disciplinary matters, Injury Reports, transfers, sanctions, permits, fundraisers, statistical purposes, and for the purposes of communicating updates about matches(Text, Teamer , WhatsApp), meetings, Club news and events; the Personal Data will be retained by the Club for, such period as my Membership subsists and for a period thereafter in line with legal obligations and other requirements;

You can resign your Membership by writing to the Club; we will need to retain your Personal Data after your Membership ceases, however only where it is necessary to do so.

If you do not provide Personal Data Membership cannot be registered with the Club. Please inform the Club of any changes to the personal data used for registration.
