- Players should ensure that they provide themselves with the official playing gear of Our Lady's Hockey Club and be well presented at all times.

MINIMUM CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL MEMBERS:

- All members of Our Lady's Hockey Club shall at all times conduct themselves in a manner that takes all reasonable measures to protect their own safety and the safety of others.
- Never use foul or abusive language or gestures.
- Never use physical abuse or threatening or intimidating behaviour.
- Respect the spirit of fair play, by participating within the rules and regulations of the game.
- Respect the rights of others, including umpires, officials, team management and other players.
- Promote the reputation of hockey and take all possible steps to prevent it from being brought into disrepute.
