



Kilkerrin United Women's World Cup Last Man Standing Competition



Competition Rules

Pay the once off entry fee of €10 and select a team to win in the first round of the 2023 Women's World Cup.

If your team wins you progress to the next round, if your team lose or draw you are out of the competition. For knockout games, a win is a win even if it takes penalties. So if your team wins after extra time or on penalties, you advance to the next round.

You can only select any team once in the competition. **NOTE** that if you advance to the semi-finals but you have already picked all 4 semi-finalists then you are eliminated from the competition.

All entries and team selections must be submitted online by 8pm on Wednesday 19th July. Submission dates/times for subsequent rounds will be advised as the competition progresses.

If your team's game is not completed due to any unforeseen circumstances you are automatically put through to the next round.

If you fail to select a team, you will be automatically assigned the first team alphabetically that you have not yet selected. The list of participating teams is listed below in alphabetical order.

The competition continues until one person remains standing and wins the pot. If two or three players remain standing, the €500 pot will be distributed evenly between those players.

You can enter the competition more than once before games commence. Each entry is independent of any others. In the event of a dispute the Kilkerrin United Last Man Standing committee will decide on all matters.
