



Camp Juniors FC: Soccer Camp rules

Effective : July 2020

Dear parent or guardian,

When registering your child for the soccer camp, **you agree to abide by the following rules of CAMP JUNIORS FC:**

- **You agree to comply with all COVID-19 related 'Safer return to training and play' rules by the FAI and you agree with all measures that Camp Juniors will implement to manage and control the risk in relation to these FAI rules.** Thereby you agree to the below points and any other measures by the club's COVID-19 Compliance Officers:
 - To respect the soccer camp drop off times and to wait until the COVID-19 officer confirms you can leave
 - To allow your child to use mandatory hand sanitizer and undergo a mandatory contactless temperature check by the COVID-19 officer before entering the training ground, after which you will be signaled by the COVID-19 officer that you can leave when your child has a confirmed temperature below 38 degrees Celsius
 - To respect all rules as outlined in the FAI documents for 'Safer return to training & play' with following link:

- **You agree that as a parent/guardian, you are responsible for:**
 - ensuring that all relevant medical conditions of your child are known to the club. If you have omitted any information by accident or because it arose during the season, please notify any of the coaching team.
 - having your child dropped off at the appropriate soccer camp session
 - collection of your child at the end of each soccer camp session
 - ensuring that your child wears shin guards at all soccer camp sessions
 - ensuring that your child turns up for the soccer camp appropriately dressed for the weather on that day & with sun-cream applied when necessary
 - being contactable during soccer camp sessions at the phone number you have given on the registration form, in case Camp Juniors needs to contact you as a result of an injury, illness or any other incident
 - respecting coaching decisions in relation to soccer camp groups, drills and practice matches
- **You agree that bad language including cursing, swearing and mocking, bullying or discrimination of other players, other kids or club coaches / officials will not be tolerated** by Camp Juniors FC and will be dealt with by the club's child welfare officer together with relevant parties including the parents. The club coaches are encouraged to utilize a system of 'sinbin' at training sessions and friendly matches in the event this type of behavior occurs and it may even lead to expulsion in the event of grave mis behavior or impact on others.
- **You agree that during soccer camp sessions, photographs may be taken by the coaching team, club officials or commercial publishers** for the purpose of utilizing these pictures for paper or internet articles, including on the club's face book page, for the purpose of the Camp Juniors FC club calendar or on the website of Camp Junior's soccer camp service provider Robin O' Day Academy. If you do not wish your child to be in these pictures, you must let the coaching team know about this. You also consent to the club as well as the soccer camp service provider Robin O' Day holding & processing data as per the registration forms, in according with the Data Protection Act and GDPR regulations.
