

Terms & Conditions

Eligibility

Lions Easter Soccer Camp is open to boys and girls currently in primary school classes from senior infants to 6th class inclusive.

Booking Confirmation

Places on the camp are limited and will be accepted on a first come first served basis following submission of both the application form and full fee of €30 per child.

Medical Consent

By completing and signing the camp application form you give your permission to allow your child to be given medical treatment either by way of first aid by a suitably qualified person or by a doctor. You also consent to your child being taken to a doctor or hospital in case of emergency. If there is any change to the medical information you provided on your application form you must inform us prior to the start of the camp.

Damages/Injuries/Loss of Possessions

Lions AFC will not be held responsible for damages, injuries or loss of possessions. We strongly recommend that all valuables be left at home. At the camp, participants may be asked to assume the position of Goalkeeper or play with participants of a different age.

Conduct

Participants must follow the instructions of the coaching staff in charge. Misbehaviour or bullying may result in the participant being expelled from the camp and any fees will not be refunded. In the interest of safety, participants are not permitted to leave the camp during the coaching session times without the consent of a parent/guardian.

Collection

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to arrange collection of their child at 1pm on each day of the camp. Children will not be allowed to leave the club grounds before 1pm but may leave the grounds after 1pm if they have not been collected and if they have indicated that they have permission from their parent/guardian to leave the grounds.

Playing Attire

All participants must wear the suitable sports clothing, runners or football boots with moulded studs and shin guards kit at all times throughout the duration of the camp.

Photographic Permission

All participants on the camp may be included in photographs for promotional purposes by Lions AFC. If any parent/guardian does not want their child to be photographed for promotional purposes, the parent/guardian must express this to the Camp Co-ordinator before the start of the camp.

Weather

Lions AFC shall not be accountable should the camp activities be suspended or cancelled due to adverse weather. In cases where the weather has affected the condition of the playing surface or is deemed so bad that coaching activities have to be suspended, the coaching staff will be available to supervise alternative indoor activities. Should the conditions show no signs of improving, the Camp Co-ordinator will contact the parent or guardian to advise them of the suspension of coaching activities if necessary. It will then be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to make arrangements to collect their child. The coaching staff will supervise all children until they have been collected.

Cancellation

All cancellations must be notified to Robbie Dempsey at 087 4115971. Refunds cannot be given in respect of cancellations made within 48 hours of the start of the camp.

Refunds

In the unlikely event that inclement weather forces the cancellation of the full camp's activities a full refund will be issued. If inclement weather causes only partial cancellation of the week, no refund will be issued.
