For all members (players, parents, guardians & volunteers)

7. I will always show respect to managers, coaches, referees, opposing teams, parents & guardians, officials and club colleagues
8. I understand that verbal and physical abuse is not to be tolerated against anyone in this organisation including profanity and foul language
9. I understand that racial epithets or negative innuendo related to a person/player's race, religion, ethnicity or physicality will not be tolerated
10. I will not create conflict by slander, malicious rumours or threats, nor will I entice others to do so
11. I will not bring disrespectful or disruptive spectators to training session or matches
12. I understand that the club is not responsible for lost or stolen items on club property

For players

13. I will always wear Club colours (blue, black & white) when playing matches
14. I will always wear Shin guards for training and matches
