For Everyone

- No abusive language or behavior towards: St Dominics FC players, Opposition players, Spectators, Coaches/Managers/Club Officials or Referees
- Respect everyone who is present on our grounds.
- Maintain discipline at all times it is a game of football being played, officiated and watched by everyone.

Players Responsibilities

- Wear all required equipment (shin guards, proper footwear & training gear).
- Pay attention to the coaches when they are speaking and instructing.
- Be a team player. Support and encourage other promoting positivity in the training and game environment.
- Be on time for all games and practices.
- Disrespectful behaviour is unacceptable and will not be tolerated towards anyone present.
- Fighting, horseplay or any physical or verbal abuse is not allowed. Any bullying will have serious consequences and will not be accepted.

• Show sportsmanship – be gracious in victory and defeat.

Parents Responsibilities

- Ensure that your child attends all practices and games. If unable to attend a game or practice, notify the coach and/or manager of the team.
- Arrive on time for training sessions.
- Ensure that your child brings all equipment to games and practices. (Shin guards, proper footwear, training gear).
- Support your child's coach and help when you can. Should matters arise, talk to the coaches involved at an appropriate time.
- Parents are encouraged to come and support their children but should refrain from offering guidance from the sideline. This only creates confusion to their child and the team. Let the coaches coach.
- Parents and spectators should adhere to a safe standing position away from the coaches and team.
- Parents are expected to set a good example for the children at all times by their positive behaviour, promoting sportsmanship, displaying good attitude and producing no foul language.
- Parents are expected to be respectful to the officials at all times.
