Supporters Code of Conduct:

- Remember that although children play organised soccer that they are not professionals. Do
 not place excessive pressure on children to perform to unrealistically high expectations.
 Children play soccer to develop their skills, to have fun and enjoy the game.
- 2. Be on your best behaviour and lead by example. The behaviour of a team's supporters will often be remembered long after the result of the game. We at Raharney United want to be remembered for the right reasons.
- 3. Applaud good play, sportsmanship and best effort by the visiting team as well as our own.
- 4. Welcome and Respect all teams on the pitch, without them there would be no match.
- 5. Condemn the use of violence in all forms at every opportunity
- 6. Verbal abuse of players, match officials or opposing supporters cannot and will not be accepted in and shape or form in Raharney United and can lead to disciplinary action.
